



What's SSW

"Specified Skilled Worker" (Tokutei Ginou) is a residence status in Japan designed to accept foreign workers who can immediately contribute in specific sectors. This new residence status system was implemented in April 2019 to address the labor shortages in industries facing severe workforce shortages.





Why Tokutei Ginou?

Duration of Residence Status

- Specified Skilled Worker (SSW) Type 1 A maximum stay of up to 5 years.
- Specified Skilled Worker (SSW) Type 2

No limit on renewals, and family accompaniment is allowed.

Technical Intern Training

A maximum stay of up to 5 years. Each stage requires a renewal of the residence status.



Why Tokutei Ginou?

Employment Conditions


Specified Skilled Worker:

Employed under the same working conditions (including salary) as Japanese workers.

• Technical Intern Training:

Conduct training based on the Technical Intern Training Plan under appropriate guidance. During this period, appropriate working conditions are guaranteed, but the focus is on guidance and education.

*As of 2020, the wages for Specified Skilled Workers are ¥12,900 higher than those for Technical Intern Trainees.



Why Tokutei Ginou?

Freedom to Change Jobs

Specified Skilled Worker:

Job changes are possible under certain conditions. It is relatively easy to change jobs within the same industry.

• Technical Intern Training:

As a general rule, changing jobs is not permitted. Changing training sites is subject to strict conditions.

The job of a Specified Skilled Worker in caregiving primarily involves caring for the elderly and disabled.



Job Descriptions

Plan B:

Food and Beverage Manufacturing

The job of a Specified Skilled Worker in food manufacturing involves tasks related to the production and processing of food.




Job Descriptions

Plan C:

Food Service

The job of a Specified Skilled Worker in the food service industry involves tasks related to cooking and serving in restaurants.



Payment Methods

Single Payment

- 1st Payment: ¥120,000 (Japanese language course fee)
- 2nd Payment: ¥50,000 (Specified skill test course fee)
- Enrollment & Administration fee: ¥10,000

Installment Payment

- 1st Payment: ¥80,000 (Japanese language course fee)
- 2nd Payment: ¥40,000 (Japanese language course fee)
- 3rd Payment: ¥50,000 (Specified skill test course fee)
- Enrollment & Administration fee: ¥10,000

*Full payment required by 1 month before the start of classes.
